

Acceptable Use Policy for KS2 pupils at Stradbroke Primary School

This is how we stay safe when we use computers, mobile phones and the internet:

I understand that while I am a member of Stradbroke Primary School I must use technology in a responsible way.

For my own personal safety:

- I understand that my use of technology (especially when I use the internet) will, wherever possible be supervised and monitored.
- I will keep my password and personal information safe and will not use anyone else's (even with their permission).
- I will tell a trusted adult if anything makes me feel uncomfortable or upset when I see it online.

For the safety of others:

- I will not interfere with the way that others use their technology.
- I will be polite and responsible when I communicate with others.
- I will not share images of anyone without their permission.

For the safety of our school:

- I will not access anything illegal.
- I will not download anything that I do not have the right to use and will only use sites our school allows.
- I will not deliberately bypass any systems designed to keep the school or organisation safe (such as filtering).
- I will tell a responsible adult if there are any faults or damage with technology, however this may have happened.
- I will be aware of "stranger danger", when I am communicating on-line.
- I understand that I am responsible for my actions and the consequences. I have read and understood the above and agree to follow these guidelines.
