We are very excited to announce that we are once again organising our annual three day residential trip to the Kingswood Centre, Peak Venture, near Penistone, in June 2022. We are very fortunate to have secured a booking again in the summer months as it is an extremely popular venue with school groups. As a school we visited this provider for the first time back in 2015, and each year since, it has proved a very successful residential experience for the Y6 children.

For parents who are new to Kingswood, they are a leading residential activity centre provider, responsible for delivering safe and rewarding educational programmes to over 130,000 children every year. By combining many National Curriculum-linked modules with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities, this trip is sure to provide the children with a wealth of new experiences outside of the classroom.

Residential courses organised by the school are, of course, an optional but invaluable part of the National Curriculum and we would love for all children to be able to go. Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that the outdoor adventure programme which we have chosen will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.
