Please make sure that the children are wearing their complete uniform. Neatly combed, and/or freshly slicked back, coiffured hair is optional, but encouraged!

This is only a temporary measure until an intercom-operated pedestrian entrance is installed over half-term for any late comers to use. To avoid any delays, try to be punctual. Thank you for your cooperation.
