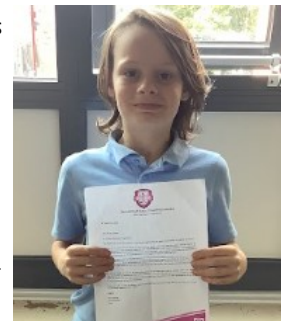
Swimming Gala
